Programme Aim

This qualification is for those currently working in, or who aspire to work in, career development services in a range of settings.

The purpose of this qualification is to provide New Zealand public and private sector organisations with people who have theoretical, technical, and applied knowledge to assist employees and prospective employees make appropriate career, transition, and training choices that will lead to a greater contribution to society and the economy.

Graduates will be able to provide professional career development services in educational and other employment settings suited to the context of cultural diversity in Aotearoa/New Zealand and a changing global economy.

Duration

Students can start at regular intervals throughout the year.

Minimum of completion is 1 year and, to maintain currency of learning, students must complete this qualification within 4 years of initial enrolment on the programme.

Entry Requirements

- Academic: A minimum of 48 credits at NCEA Level 2 across four subjects including a minimum of 12 credits Literacy at NCEA level 2 (or equivalent). For applicants 20 years of age and over there are no minimum academic requirements. Evidence to support an applicant's ability to successfully undertake study at Level 6 with a reasonable likelihood of success will be requested (for example life experience, work experience, successful completion of study at Level 5).
- English requirements: All applicants must have a level of English sufficient to be able to study at this level. For those applicants for whom English is not their first language the following is required:
- An IELTS overall score of 6.0 with no band score lower than 5.5, issued within the last 2 years
 - **or** a TOEFL score of at least 213 in the computer based test, or at least 550 in the paper test, issued in the last 2 years
 - **or** a qualification considered to be equivalent to the above

- Special entry: In exceptional circumstances, an applicant under the age of 20 years who does not meet the academic entry requirements may be granted entry to the Diploma in Career Development where they supply evidence to satisfy the relevant Academic Committee of their ability to succeed on the Programme.
- Applicants must also submit:
 - A health declaration and confidentiality form
 - A current Ministry of Justice Criminal Conviction Report
 - Two referee reports

There are also fees associated with this qualification.
